

Pregnancy And Breast Feeding

PREGNANCY: Please notify Dr. Mitchell **IMMEDIATELY** if you are pregnant. Due to the difficulties in coordinating patient medical care with obstetric physicians, Dr. Mitchell can no longer treat pregnant patients. If possible, he will try to help you find a doctor who does.

BREAST FEEDING: Please notify Dr. Mitchell **IMMEDIATELY** if you are breast feeding your baby. Small amounts of Suboxone and Subutex can pass through breast milk from the mother to the child. Dr. Mitchell can treat patients who are breast feeding. However, since Subutex contains only buprenorphine and not any naloxone like Suboxone, all patients who are breast feeding must be on **SUBUTEX**.
